Arkansas	No bumping (except when same business is on more than one sign)

Minnesota	Bumping for closer business occurs at permit renewal or after one year of bump request, whichever occurs first.

Missouri	Bumping permitted only of a business that was granted a waiver	

Nebraska	Bumping permitted after 1 year

Ohio	No bumping. Previously permitted bumping but eliminated because of all the issues. Prefer the first come first served.
